Jim was a member of Council for two years. He served on the Public Relations Committee for one year, the Employee Engineers Committee for four years, the Nominating Committee for one year, the Legislation Committee for fourteen years and the Ad Hoc Committee to Review the Code of Ethics for four years.

The Association was pleased to grant Honorary Life Membership to Jim in 1987 in recognition of his long record of meritorious service to the Association. He was also the recipient of the Association's Merit Award in 1987, in recognition of his significant contributions as an engineer, to the development of codes and standards, and of his outstanding service to the community. Jim is only the second member in the Association's history to have received all three Association awards.
