RICHARD ALLAN (DICK) JOHNSON

Professor Dick Johnson became registered with APEM on December 12, 1955, and has been a member continuously for 43 years. He graduated from the University of Manitoba with a B.Sc. (1954), and an M.Sc. (1956) in Electrical Engineering.

Dick was a member of Council from 1977 to 1980, and was President in 1979. He served on the Executive & Finance Committee for four years, the Board of Examiners for seven years (three as Chair), the Committee to Study the Act for one year, the Advisory Committee on the Code of Ethics for three years, the Legislation Committee for six years, of which he is currently a member, the Awards Committee for six years, the Nominating Committee for five years, the Registration Procedures Review Committee for three years, the Ad Hoc Committee on the Log of Experience for one year and for three years on the Select Committee of Past Presidents. He has also served on the Investigation Committee for nine years (two as Chair), of which he is currently a member. This totals 52 committee years of service. Dick received APEM's Outstanding Service Award in 1976.

In addition to his activities in the APEM, Dick was actively involved with the Canadian Council of Professional Engineers (CCPE). He served as Chair of the Committee on Acceptable Canadian Engineering Curriculum which recommended the creation and structure of the Canadian (Engineering) Accreditation Board, on which he subsequently served as a member.

After a long and distinguished career at the University of Manitoba, in the Faculty of Engineering and central administration, he retired on September 1, 1997.

The Association is indebted to Dick Johnson for the wide variety of service rendered by him in so many areas of the Association's activities. He is a respected member — one who is most articulate and always willing to share his wit and insight with great aplomb. It is with pride that the Association bestows Honorary Life Membership on Dick Johnson.
