Malcolm Symonds was registered with APEM on July 23, 1979, and has been a member continuously for 19 years. He graduated from the University of Manitoba with a B.Sc. degree in Mechanical Engineering in 1977. He is the Director of Engineering Services at Bristol Aerospace Limited.

Malcolm was a member of Council from 1993 to 1998, and was President in 1997. He has served on the Executive & Finance Committee for three years, the Discipline Committee for five years, the Salary Research Committee for nine years, the Consulting Engineers Committee for two years, the Selection Committee for one year, the Awards Committee for one year, the Nominating Committee for three years, the Organizational Restructuring Action Plan (ORAP) Committee for one year, the Ad Hoc Committee - Technologists for three years, and the Ad Hoc Committee on the Electronic Seal for one year. In total, he has provided 35 committee years of service to the Association.

Malcolm was instrumental in defining the APEM vision, which served as the first of many steps taken by the Association in reorganizing its activities. The vision is the fundamental principle underlying everything the Association does for the public of Manitoba.
