Andrew Baracos became registered with this Association on February 27, 1953, and has been a member continuously for 49 years. Andy graduated from the University of Alberta with a B.Sc. (1947) and a M.Sc. (1949) in Civil Engineering.

Andy served as a member of Council from 1967 to 1970. He also served on the Board of Examiners (now the Academic Review Committee) for 12 years, the Advisory Committee for two years, the Committee to Study the Engineering Profession Act for one year, the Nominating Committee for one year the Anniversary Year Liaison Committee for one year and the Compensation Study Ad Hoc Committee for one year. This makes a total of 21 committee-years of service.

His career has been at the University of Manitoba, Department of Civil Engineering, and he was the first Head of the Department of Geological Engineering. He has accomplished many pioneering achievements and is recognized as the father of soil mechanics in Manitoba. It is estimated that he taught 2,500 undergraduate and 200 graduate students in his long career at the University from 1949-1989. Andy was appointed Professor Emeritus in May 1997.

Andy received the Association's Merit Award in 1988.
