Job Profile

Under the general direction of the Traffic Management Engineer, the Network Management Engineer is primarily responsible for managing temporary use of the street right-of-way, and the issuance of overweight and over-dimensional permits.

As the Network Management Engineer you will:

- Maintain the City of Winnipeg's Manual of Temporary Traffic Control.
- Lead, train and supervise the roles of Permits Clerk and By-law Enforcement Officer; will lead any changes to applicable technology, software, and enforcement practices.
- Oversee the issuance and enforcement of "use of streets permits"; will provide approvals and conditions as required.
- Provide direction to the By-law Enforcement Officer on violations of the streets, traffic, and encroachment by-laws related to the use of streets permits, crossing permits, encroachments, and general temporary traffic control.
- Supervise the regional street lane closure process.
- Supervise issuance of over-dimension and over-weight vehicle permits.
- Participate in the City Special Events Committee and administer special events for grants related to traffic services.
- Design temporary traffic control plans for construction projects and implement/monitor.
- Provide input to changes to traffic by-law, parking by-law, zoning by-law, and truck route schedules as required.
- Manage temporary uses of the streets right-of-way.
- Review permanent uses of the streets right-of-way.
- Oversee the implementation of temporary speed limits and designated construction zones.
- Act as the Traffic Management Engineer for short-term coverage.

Your education and qualifications include:

- Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering, with courses in Traffic Engineering and Transportation Engineering.

- Minimum of 2 (two) years of related work experience within the transportation industry.
- Ability to manage a high volume workload and adjust as necessary to changing conditions and priorities.
- Excellent interpersonal skills with the ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with a variety of internal and external stakeholders (co-workers, consultants, contractors, councillors, members of the public, etc.).
- Experience preparing technical reports.
- Experience and proficiency working with software programs including Microsoft Office Suite.
- Ability to work independently on research and analysis activities.
- Ability to develop recommendations and reports summarizing research and analysis activities.
- Ability to apply sound judgement and demonstrate political acumen.
- Excellent decision making skills, with ability analyze information in a timely manner.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Strong presentation skills with the ability to present information to a variety of audiences.
- Strong leaderships skills with the ability to train, delegate, and manage the work of subordinate staff.
