An eligibility list may be created for similar positions and will remain in effect for 12 months.

The Office of the Fire Commissioner is a special operating agency of the Manitoba government that performs a critical role in ensuring and maintaining Manitoba's public safety. The overall mission is to safeguard both persons and property from fire and life safety hazards through education, investigation, emergency response and code application.

A recognized trade certificate, and extensive field experience in a related field may be considered.
- Experience reading and interpreting construction drawings, procedures and weld specifications

Duties:

The Inspector- Design Surveyor reviews and registers pressure equipment, reviews and inspects repairs, conducts inspections of newly constructed pressure equipment, performs quality assurance (Q/A) audits of Q/A programs approved by the Agency, and conducts pressure welding examinations. The Inspector-Design Surveyor ensures compliance with various pieces of technical safety legislation, their supporting regulations, and reference codes and standards including (but not limited to), The Steam and Pressure Plants Act, The Power Engineers Act, The Gas and Oil Burner Act and The Technical Safety Act (not yet proclaimed).
