The Opportunity

Reporting to the Director, Airport Planning and Infrastructure or a Project Manager, the **Project Coordinator** will work within the Airport Planning and Infrastructure Department to provide project planning, implementation and management of civil, structural, architectural and specialized airport infrastructure projects. The Project Coordinator will:

- Provide direct field supervision and engineering support for airport capital projects, maintenance activities and technical support for airport operations;
- Coordinate the work of contractors, consultants, service providers and internal WAA staff.
- Provide recommendations, advice and technical support on facility maintenance activities and project planning;
- Interpret construction drawings and specifications;
- Develop and produce technical drawings, specifications, for assembly of tender package.
- Prepare planning schedules identifying resources and completion times for all assigned projects.
- Ensure compliance with regulations, laws, rules, specifications and procedures set forth by governing bodies;
- Communicate, schedule and organize actions with internal and external parties;
- Be responsible for performance of construction site inspections, site layout, and quantity measurements;
- Collect and process survey data with use of robotic total station, level, GPS and Lidar;
- Perform ongoing inspections and report on WAA inventory;
- Provide engineering technical support;
- Produce, update and maintain technical documentation for airport publications.
- Produce designs for airport, civil and municipal infrastructure in AutoCAD Civil 3D;
- Perform variety of field and office duties as directed by project managers;
- Coordinate underground utility locates for airport utility infrastructure;
- Interact and effectively communicate with project staff, contractors, consultants and the public;
- Work independently and within a team environment;



Requirements:

- Degree in Civil Engineering or diploma in Civil Engineering Technology and a minimum of 5 years direct work experience; Civil, Municipal Engineering, Geomatics Technology, or Construction Management is preferred;
- Minimum designation of Certified Engineering Technologist (C.E.T) or Engineering Interim (EIT) (WAA will support the licensure and assist any new EIT in obtaining a Professional Engineer (P.Eng.) status.
- Experience in engineering design, quality control practices, or project management/coordination;
- Knowledge of airport specific engineering practices, construction, rules and regulations is considered an asset;
- Extensive knowledge of specifications, regulations, codes and by-laws;
- Advanced computer, mathematical, technical and problem solving skills;
- Demonstrated AutoCAD Civil 3D drafting and municipal infrastructure design as well as advanced surveying skills with Total Station and GPS equipment is preferred;
- Knowledge of civil infrastructure, pavements and infrastructure systems, including building architectural, electrical, mechanical, or structural systems;
- Ability to work under high pressure situations within tight deadlines and budgets;
- Ability to lift heavy objects and work in extreme hot/cold conditions for extended periods;
- Must possess and maintain a valid Class 5 Manitoba Driver's License;
- Condition of employment is the ability to obtain an Airport Restricted Area Identification Card (RAIC) and an airside vehicle operators permit (D-AVOP) with radio telephone operator's restricted certificate (Aeronautical);

Selection Criteria:

- Minimum of 5 years direct work experience;
- Ability to perform AutoCAD Civil 3D drafting and municipal infrastructure design is preferred;
- Experience in the heavy construction industry;
- Strong computer skills and experience working with Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Outlook, Project, PowerPoint), Adobe Pro and Autodesk CADD applications;
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills;
- Must have excellent interpersonal skills and a willingness to work in a team setting;
- Ability to manage time effectively;
- Knowledge of Transport Canada Aerodrome Standards (TP312), Airport operations and maintenance procedures will be considered an asset;
- Winnipeg Airports Authority is a federally regulated environment, all employees are required to be Covid-19 vaccinated.
