



REMITTANCE FOR LATE EXPERIENCE

Note 1: Under the new rules of the Pre-Registration Program adopted January 1, 2005, Late but otherwise eligible experience may be credited if an Administrative penalty is paid. The penalty is calculated on a 'per-month basis' and is currently equal to \$21.40 (including GST) per month claimed.

Note 2: Late months are defined as any experience gained prior to 8 months of APEGM's receiving the MIT progress report. For example – a report which covers the time period from January 1, 2005 to June 30, 2005 (6 months), should be received by August 31, 2005 (2 months later). If the same report is received instead on September 30, 2005 (1 month late), experience can be counted from February 1, 2005 onward (8 months prior to September 30, 2005). Experience from February 1, 2005 to June 30, 2005 (5 months) is therefore deemed Regular experience. Experience from January 1, 2005 to February 1, 2005 (1 month) is deemed Late experience. The MIT has the option of either having that experience discounted or paying an Administrative sanction of \$21.40 per month to have that late but otherwise eligible experience counted. The 8 month rule applies whether the MIT has full-time or part-time work or has had a period of unemployment.

Note 3: Because it is far easier to track, late months will no longer be subtracted from your experience total. Instead, time will be added to your program. For example, if you submit a 6 month report and two of those months are deemed late, you will be credited with 6 months towards the Pre-Registration program, but you will be required to attain 50 months of experience rather than 48 months. If you pay the Administrative sanction for these extra 2 months ($21.40 \times 2 = \$42.80$), your total time requirement will again revert to 48 months.

Note 4: You may opt to pay the Administrative sanction on part of your late time only. For example, if you currently have been credited with 10 late months (58 months required on the Pre-Registration program), you may, if you wish, opt to pay for only 5 of those late months. In this case, you would remit $\$21.40 \times 5 = \107.00 . The remaining late months (5 months) will remain added to your 48 month time requirement. Therefore your total time requirement would become 53 months rather than 58 months. You must however, pay for the late time in multiples of ½ months – i.e. $\$21.40/2 = \10.70 . Remittances which are not in ½ month multiples will not be accepted.
