

## CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

### **Academic Review Committee**

The Academic Review Committee (ARC) is responsible for assessing the academic credentials of those applicants who do NOT have a Canadian bachelor's degree in engineering or geoscience. The ARC is made up of registered professionals from all engineering and geoscience disciplines.

### General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review files of applicants provided by Association staff.
- Participate in regular meetings with the ARC to discuss issues and policy development related to this committee.

### Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Be a Professional Engineer (P.Eng.) who has experience in the field of Electrical Engineering, with the sub-disciplines of Powers and Controls.
- Preferably with a post-graduate degree in the discipline specified. An academic background is desirable but not required.
- Be able to commit to reviewing files on a regular basis.
- Be available for meetings either in person or by teleconference
- Be available on a regular basis for interviews of applicants – usually once or twice per year.

### Time Commitment:

The committee meets every second month (6 times a year) with the meetings running approximately 1-2 hours in length. Attendance at all meetings is not mandatory and committee members are able to attend by teleconference. Policy meetings (which are once per year) are especially important.
