General Duties and Responsibilities:

- On Wednesday June 14, two volunteers are needed from 4:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. to pick up items from the Association office and drive a 5 ton truck (provided) to The Links at Quarry Oaks for set up. One volunteer will then caravan with the truck and drive both volunteers back (second vehicle not provided, volunteer must have access to own vehicle).
- Volunteers must have a valid Manitoba Driver's License and be physically able to load and unload a truck. Dinner and gas reimbursement will be provided.
