Professional Practice Examination Screening Group Member

The <u>National Professional Practice Examination</u> (NPPE) confirms knowledge of professionalism, law, and ethics. All fourteen engineering and geoscience self-regulatory organizations in Canada currently use the NPPE as a requirement for licensure.

The Professional Practice Examination Screening Group (PPESG) assists in developing appropriate questions for the NPPE that are current, meaningful, and relevant. It does this through reviewing and assessing new questions to ensure that they are appropriate for the member's jurisdiction and profession, the blueprint, and for comprehension.

The Nominating Regulator Group is seeking a professional member from Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba for the PPESG.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review and assess new questions when requested and provide comments through an online platform, in a timely fashion.
- Maintain knowledge of the Professional Practice Examination blueprint and suggested reading materials.

Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- Be in good standing with the nominating regulator and have a license to practice engineering or geoscience with a minimum of five years of industry experience postlicensure
- Have a good understanding of public interest and self-regulation
- Have a good understanding of good character and reputation
- Have a good understanding of professionalism and professional ethics
- Have excellent communication skills: written, reading, and comprehension
- Be an open-minded individual with ability to put complicated scenarios into context
- Be detail oriented

Time Commitment:

Preparation and time commitments are estimated as follows:

 Independent review and comment of 45-50 questions per month (approximately 4-6 hours per month)



- Occasional short virtual meetings as needed to clarify comments
- Annual in-person meeting and training session in APEGA's Edmonton or Calgary office (expenses paid by APEGA) (1-2 days, plus travel)
- · Additional time as needed for onboarding
- Term of office for this position is three years (renewable)
