NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Nominating Committee assists in identifying election candidates who meet the criteria for councillors as described in the Governance Policy GP-6. The Committee does this by asking members to recommend nominees who are willing to serve as a councillor in the governance of the Association.

General Duties and Responsibilities

- Produce a suitable slate of candidates for the upcoming election; replacing any vacancies on Council.
- Contact potential candidates to explain: role of the councillor, opportunity to govern, election process, time commitment and related details.
- Confirm whether or not potential candidates are willing to stand for election should the committee select them as a preferred candidate.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Looking for five new committee members: four being either P.Eng. or P.Geo. and one Engineering Intern.
- Strong understanding of governance, succession planning and board/council functioning.
- Experience in Human Resources; specifically, screening applicants/interviewing/selection.
- Well connected with other professional members.

Time Commitment:

The Nominating Committee will meet approximately once a month over a six-month period, with meetings typically being over the lunch hour. There may be some correspondence by email.
