General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review documentation provided by the applicant and recommend these files for registration by Council.
- Participate in regular monthly meetings with the Registration Committee to discuss issues and policy development related to this committee.
- Where required, participate in registration and reinstatement appeals.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Be a P.Eng. with expertise in electrical engineering in good standing with the Association
- Be a P.Eng. with expertise in Civil/Structural engineering in good standing with the Association
- These volunteer positions are ideal for individuals who are committed to assisting Interns and members to move forward in the registration process
- Be able to commit to reviewing files on a regular basis
- Be available for meetings either in person or by teleconference

Time Commitment:

The committee meets every month (12 times a year) with the meetings running approximately 1-2 hours in length. Meetings are typically the last Wednesday of the month and are held over the lunch hour.
