The Role

In this role, you will:

- Ensure acquisition and management of diamond drill core logging, record data into the database and verify the accurate selection and shipment of core samples
- Have oversight for underground tunneling, provide guidance on development, ground conditions and ensure prints are followed
- Be responsible for recording and reporting NATM activity, underground mapping of development headings, computerized data management, data quality assurance/quality control (QA/QC) and radiometric probing

Required:

- Bachelor's degree in geology or geological engineering
- Minimum of two years of relevant geological/mine geology experience (core logging, underground geological mapping)
- Experience working in an underground work environment
- Strong verbal and written communication skills, excellent computer skills and the ability to work independently and in a team environment
- Ability and willingness to perform manual labour, including heavy lifting, as required for this position
- Valid class 5 driver's licence
- Safety-oriented work attitude
- Work a rotational schedule, including night shift, and commute to site by aircraft
