Applicants must be professional members of Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba, in good standing and reside in the province of Manitoba.

I declare that I meet the personal qualifications for elected councillors as set out in By-law 4.2.1, that no person shall be an elected councillor if that person:

- (a) is not an individual;
- (b) is not a resident of Manitoba;
- (c) is less than 18 years of age;
- (d) has the status of bankrupt;
- (e) is of unsound mind and has been so found by a court in Canada or elsewhere; and
- (f) is not in good standing.

I declare that I am familiar with *The Engineering and Geoscientific Professions Act, Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba By-laws, Council policies and procedures, and Robert’s Rules of Order.*
