ABOUT THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Nominating Committee is a committee of Council responsible for identifying election candidates who meet the criteria outlined in the Governance Policy for Councillor Roles and Job Description (GP-6).

For this year, Council is looking for **one intern** and **at least one professional member (P.Eng. or P.Geo.)** to join the committee.

TIME COMMITMENT

The committee typically meets once a month between February and June. Meetings are held virtually and last approximately one hour.

GENERAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop a slate of qualified candidates for Council election for review at the June Council meeting, in alignment with the Act and By-laws and with consideration for broad membership diversity.
- Contact potential nominees to explain the councillor role, election process, time commitment, and other relevant details.
- Report back to the committee on whether potential nominees are willing to stand for election if selected as preferred candidates.

DESIRED SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- A strong professional network within the membership.
- A basic understanding of governance, succession planning, and board/Council functions.
- Experience in Human Resources (e.g., screening applicants, interviewing, selection) is an asset but not required.
